
Printable Ring Sizer

Use our printable ring sizer to obtain an accurate measurement for the ring you plan on purchasing. You can measure either your bride's finger or a ring she already owns to find her ring size. With this easy-to-use tool at your disposal, you'll have no trouble discovering what size ring to buy for a perfect fit! Printing Tips

It is crucial that you follow these printing instructions carefully to ensure an accurate measurement.

- 1. Set the Scaling option to "None" in your printer settings.
- 2. Using a ruler, measure the bar below to confirm that it is exactly 3.5 inches long.
- 3. If the control bar is not exactly 3.5 inches, check your printer settings again and confirm that the page is set to print at the full size (not cropped or scaled to fit).



Follow these steps to use the finger measurement tool:

- 1. Print this page.
- 2. Carefully cut out the finger measurement tool below.
- 3. Cut a small slit on the wide end where marked.
- 4. Wrap the sizing tool around the desired finger (be sure the numbered side of the tool is facing out).
- 5. Insert the narrow end of the tool into the slit you cut in step 3.
- 6. Move the tool over the largest part of the finger (probably the knuckle) and pull the narrow end through the slit to tighten the sizing tool.
- 7. Record the number that appears at the slit; this is the ring size to purchase.

Tips: Measure the finger at the end of the day when fingers tend to be the largest. Also, avoid measuring cold fingers, as this may skew the results.
